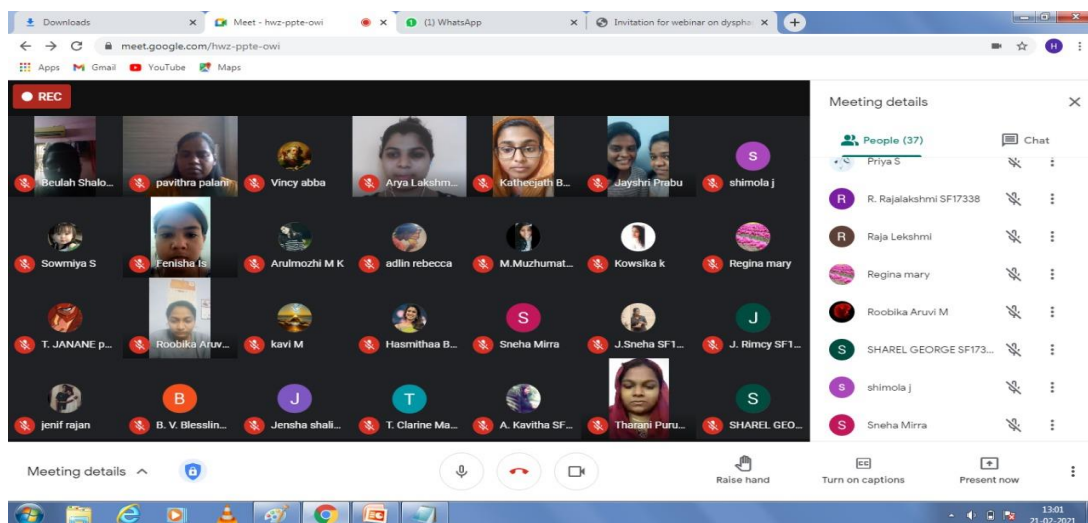
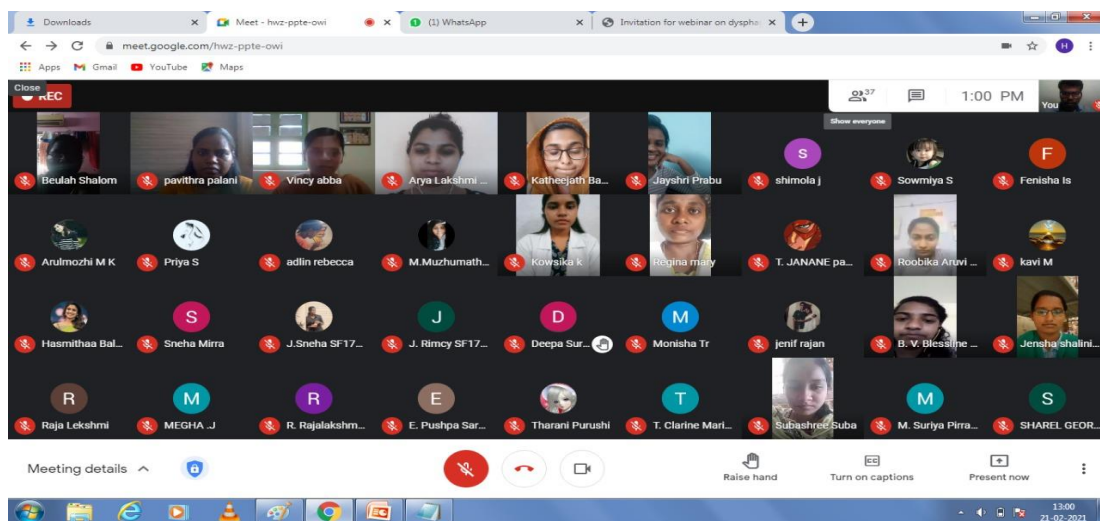
Power Trust – Viralimalai Audiological & Speech and Language Screening Camp

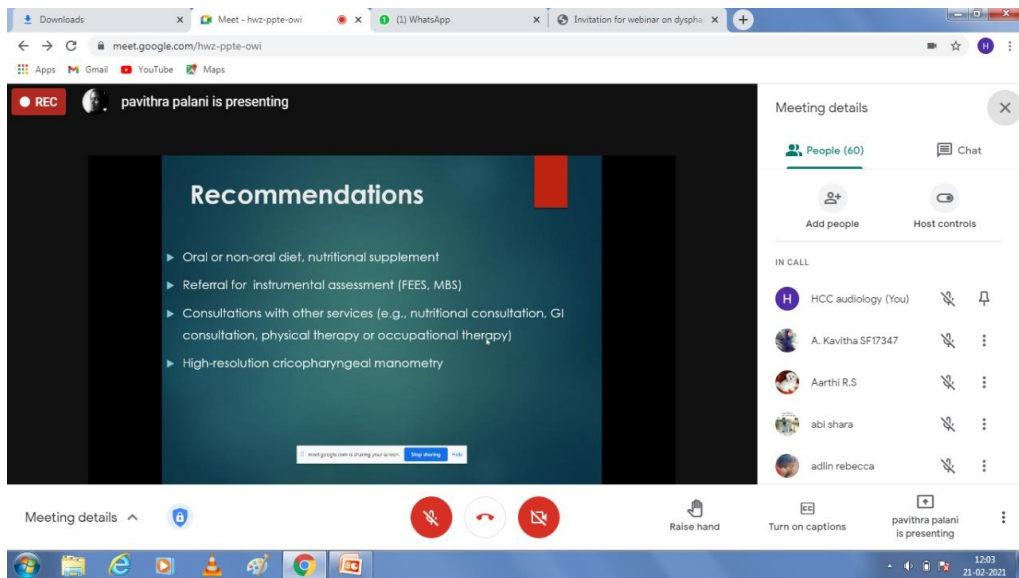
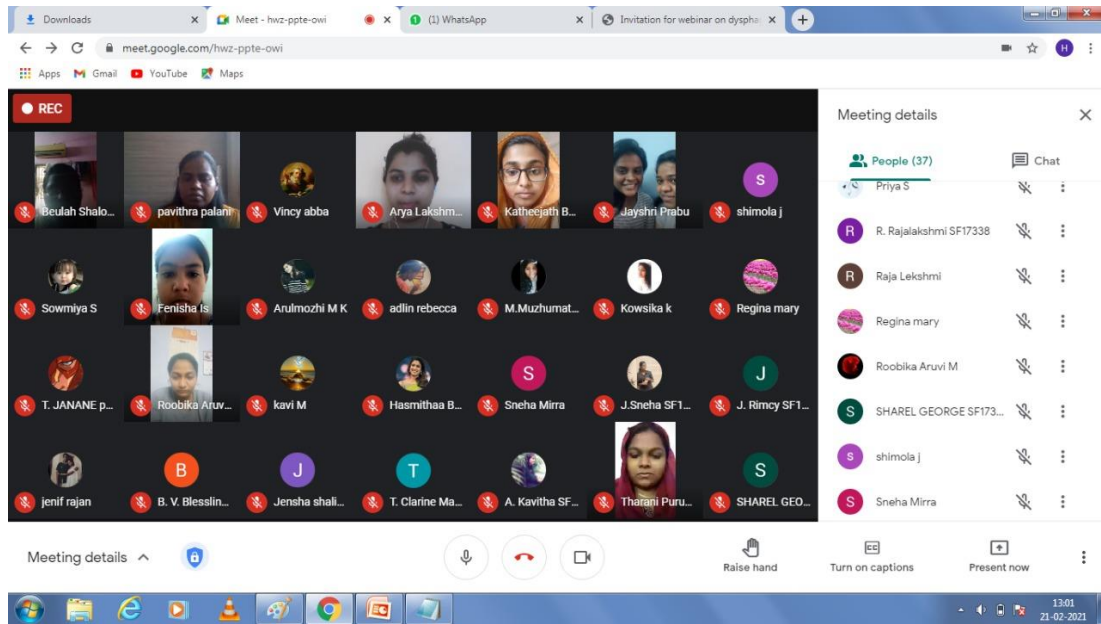

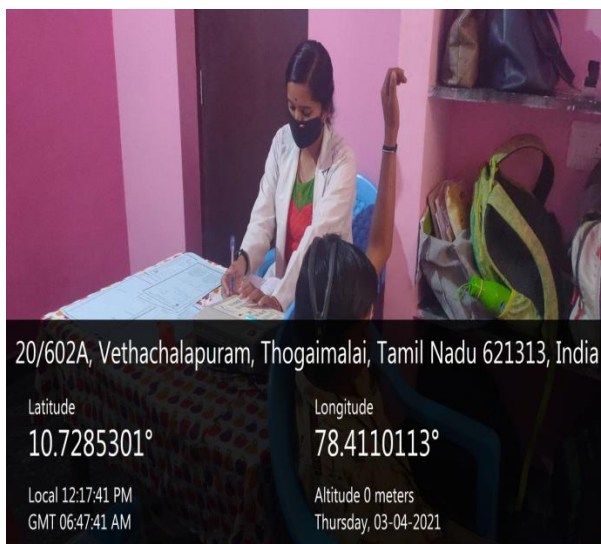
World Hearing Day Report

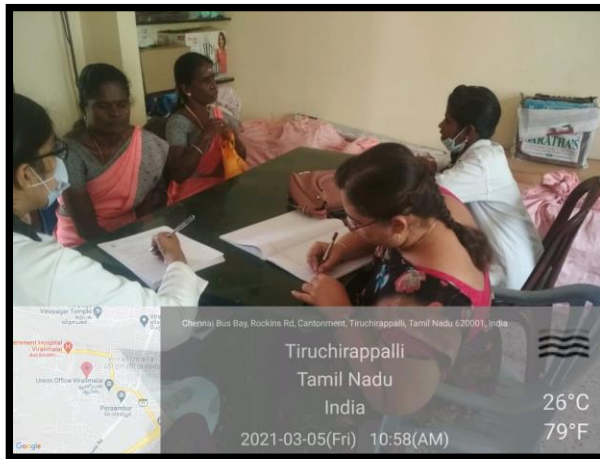
Non Organizational Government (NGO) - Thokaimalai Audiological & Speech and Language Screening Camp

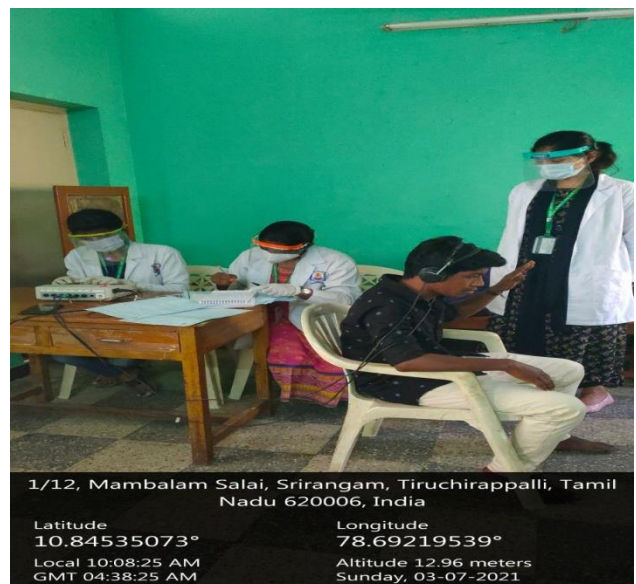
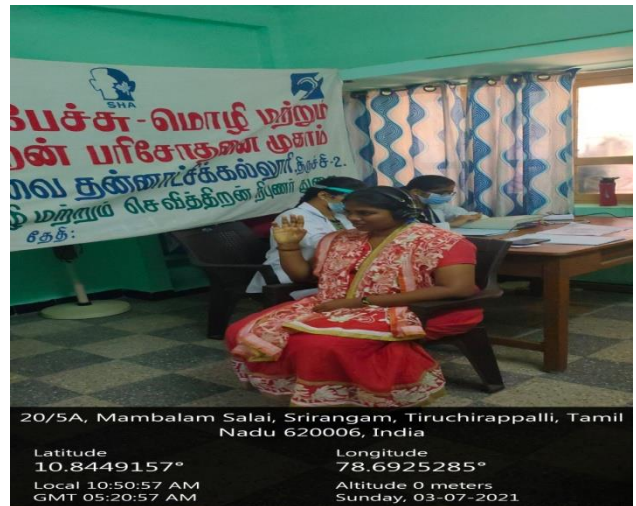
Power Trust - Viralimalai Audiological & Speech and Language Screening Camp

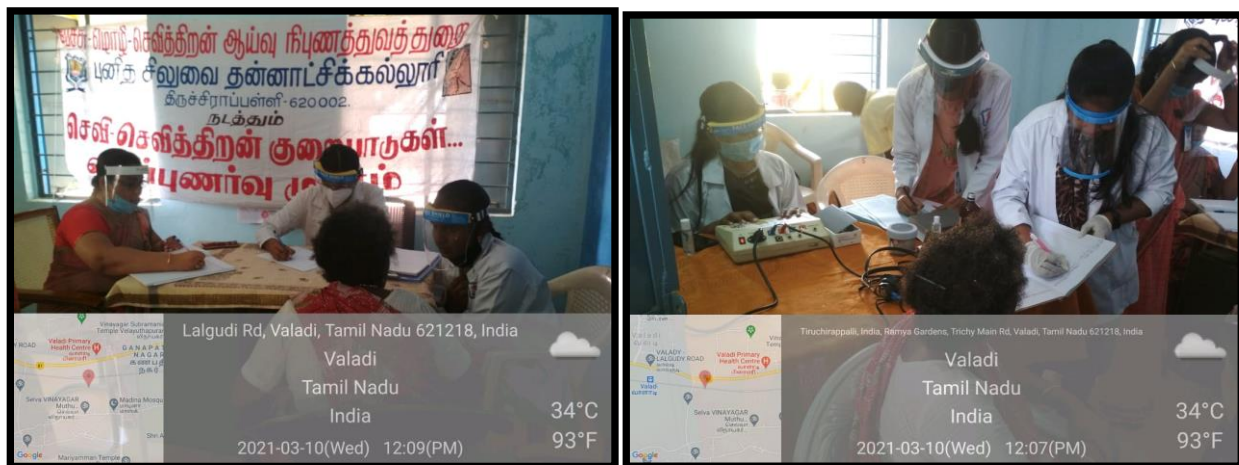
St. Antony's Church - Mambalasalai Audiological & Speech and Language Screening Camp

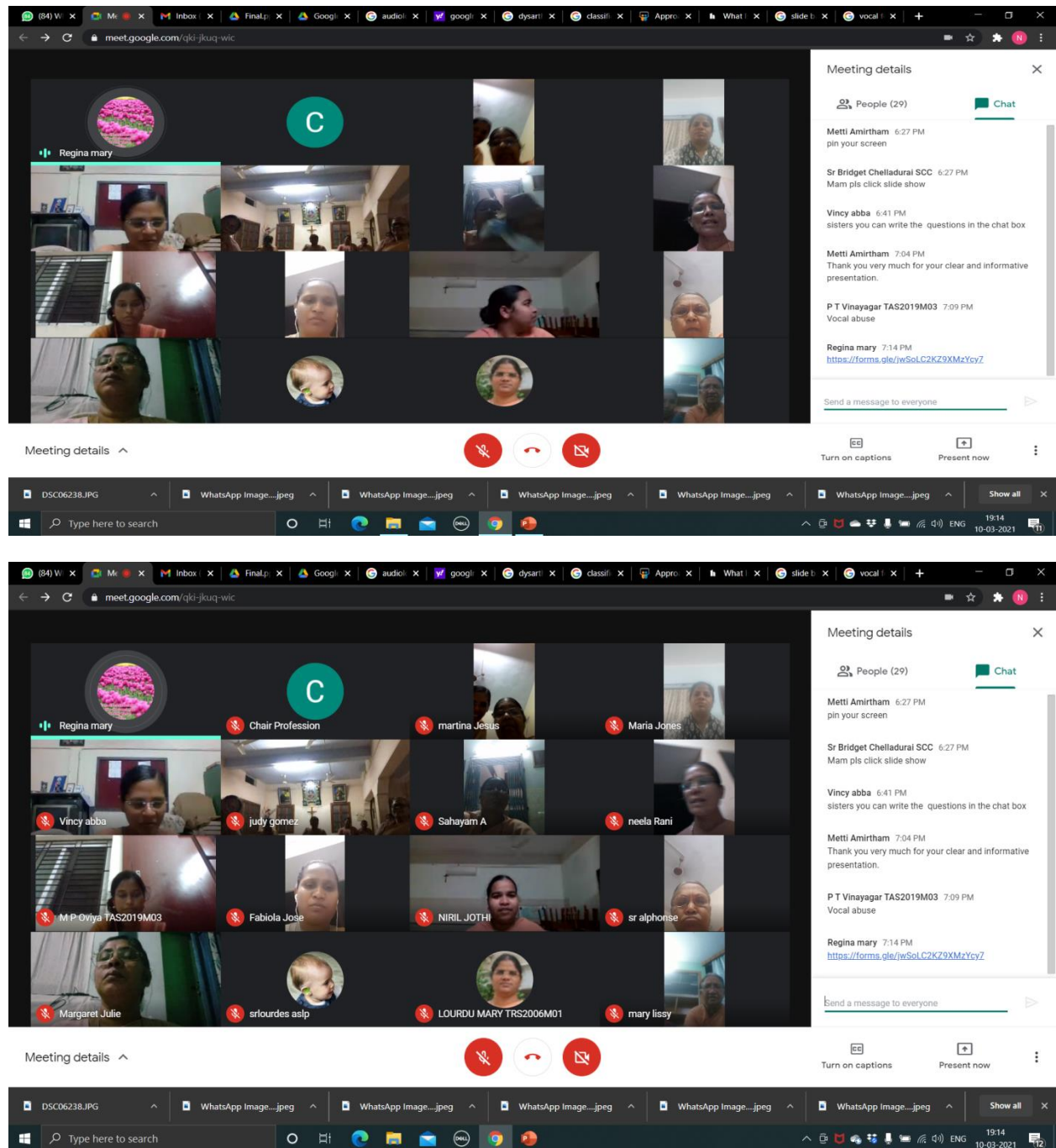
